BEIJING FOLLOW-UP

We are working diligently to conclude our Beijing Games sales and operations. In this regard, we are calculating royalties and commissions that are due to NOCs as well as to some sub-agents. **Lurdes Muñoz** is currently communicating directly with the sub-agents about any commissions and we will share the same information with each NOC at the upcoming PASO meetings in Acapulco.

PASO MEETINGS

As indicated above, we will be attending the PASO meetings in Acapulco next month. We arrive the evening of **October 7 and depart October 13**. We will not be hosting a formal meeting or reception as we have done in the past but we do look forward to meeting with each NOC individually for about 20 to 30 minutes to review Beijing and to discuss the Vancouver and London Games. In addition, there are some NOCs that have some pending paperwork and agreements that need to be signed for future Games. We will schedule meetings with you directly in Acapulco and want to thank you in advance for making time to meet with us.

VANCOUVER 2010

As indicated previously, the deadline for ordering Vancouver 2010 tickets was 30 May 2008. We are still willing to serve as an Authorized Ticket Reseller (ATR) for NOCs, but unfortunately, it will be difficult to submit any more ticket orders to the Vancouver Organizing Committee (VANOC).
